“INLAWS & OUTLAWS” RETURNS TO TACOMA FOR VALENTINE’S Local Film Highlights True Stories of Gay & Straight Couples

(SEATTLE) Filmed in Seattle and premiering at SIFF, the crowd-pleasing documentary “Inlaws & Outlaws” returns to Tacoma for an exclusive engagement at the **Grand Cinema** — just in time for Valentine’s Day. With these screenings, the filmmaker, Drew Emery, is launching a national tour of the film in indie theatres with the support of congregations, schools and equality organizations. Dubbed the Hearts + Minds Campaign, the film’s unusual path to self-distribution has allowed a film to break into communities that normally wouldn’t be receptive to a film that deals with gay relationships — including churches and schools from Texas to Oklahoma and Indiana.

“We’ve been very lucky to be embraced by churches and community organizations like PFLAG in Tacoma,” says Emery. “Aside from folks appreciating how entertaining a film it is, I think it’s a reflection of the power of true stories to move dialogue forward in a positive way.”

“Inlaws & Outlaws” first played in Tacoma in last Fall’s Tacoma Film Festival.
